## Bilateral cooperation

- New German government continues strong emphasis on energy, climate and development
- Current energy projects with 42 partner countries
- Several regional and global projects
- Main focus on Asia (over 60%)



## Johannesburg 2002 commitment achieved

- Target „1 billion € within 5 years“ has been achieved within 3 years (2003-2005)
- More than half on RE
- 88 energy projects in 30 cooperation countries
- Main focus on Asia ( approx. 45%),  
South East Europe/Caucasian Region (approx. 20%)  
and the MENA Region (approx. 15%)



## Special Loan Facility for RE and EE

- Commitment at *renewables2004*: Concessional loans of 500 million € within 2005 - 2009
- Facility has been established by KfW
- Eligible: state and parastatal institutions in developing countries
- In 2005: 170 million €

## Follow-up of *renewables2004*

- REN21
  - began its work in June 2005
  - Secretariat in Paris since February 2006, organized by GTZ and UNEP
  - Global Status Report 2005
- Follow-up conference *Beijing International Renewables Conference 2005* (BIREC2005)
- International Action Programme will be monitored by REN21 for CSD 14
